Ballot Initiatives

Ballot initiatives provide Arizona voters with one of the most direct ways to make their voices heard. These initiatives can shape state laws, amend the constitution, and redefine the possibilities for the state's future.

Prop 139

Abortion Access Act Amendment

- Amends the Arizona Constitution to provide a fundamental right to abortion.
- Bars the state from unfairly limiting access to abortion.

Prop 134

Signature Distribution Requirement for Initiatives Amendment

- Would require ballot initiatives to secure a certain amount of signatures from each AZ legislative district instead of weighing all petitions evenly.
- Would make it more difficult and expensive for regular Arizonans to get initiatives onto the ballot.

Prop 136

Legal Challenges to Constitutionality of Initiatives Amendment

- Would make it easier to challenge ballot initiatives and constitutional amendments before voters can cast their ballots.
- Would make it more difficult and expensive for regular Arizonans to get initiatives onto the ballot.

Ballot Initiatives (continued)

Prop 137

End Term Limits and Retention Elections for Supreme Court Justices and Superior Court Judges

- Would remove term limits for high level Arizona Judges, allowing them to serve unlimited terms.
- Would remove retention elections which allow voters to retain or remove a judge periodically.

Prop 138

Wages for Tipped Workers Amendment

 Would allow restaurant owners to pay employees 25% less per hour if they make \$13.35/hr including tips.

Prop 314

Immigration and Border Law Enforcement Measure

 Would empower Arizona police at all levels to investigate and detain anyone they suspect of being undocumented.
